

## **Parish Council Photographic Calendar Competition**

**The theme will be images of ‘Robin’ from various aspects, times of year, and a montage from his original construction. We will also invite children in year groups 3 and 4 at Pegswood Primary, to submit either a drawing or photograph of ‘Robin’.**

- 1. Entries are subject to a limit of two categories and one digital photograph per chosen category:**

---

  - a. Each photo must be at least 6 megabytes in size – so please take your image in High Definition if possible**
  - b. Please ensure the photograph is landscape in style – if a portrait photograph is entered it will not be considered**
  - c. Please email your entry to pegswoodclg@gmail.com including your name, the category, your address including postcode.**

**These are the entry categories;**

- **Sunrise or sunset**
  - **Spring, Summer, Autumn or Winter**
  - **“Your favourite View”**
  - **From an unusual angle**

- 2. By entering the competition you hereby accept the rules, terms and conditions.**
  - 3. It is free to enter and open to all members of the public. If you are under 16 you must have your parent/guardian consent to participate in the competition.**
  - 4. The photographs must be received by 10am Tuesday 31 July 2018. If you have any problems in sending via email please contact the Parish Office on 01670 514299**
  - 5. You must be the sole owner and author of each entry.**
  - 6. No signature, stamp or any other identifying marker is allowed on entry photographs and they must not infringe upon copyright, trademarks or any other intellectual property rights of any third person or entity.**
  - 7. On application you are agreeing that Pegswood Parish Council has permission to use your personal details (name and town only) and photographs in the calendar publication (and any publicity connected with it), which will go on sale to the public.**
  - 8. Copyright and all other rights remain that of the photographer.**
  - 9. Please ensure you have provided a postal address on the entry form.**
  - 10. Entries will judged by persons independent of the Parish Council and their decision will be final.**
  - 11. No applications accepted after deadline date/time.**
